

HOW TO REGISTER

Before Election Day

Completed voter registration forms may be mailed to your county auditor and must be received by 5:00 p.m. CT or postmarked fifteen days prior to the election. Registration forms submitted online must be completed at or before 11:59 p.m. CT, fifteen days prior to the election.

Within 15 days of Election Day

Any voter that is not registered on or before 15 days of the election may still register and vote by providing proof of identity and residence at the polls. This is called *Election Day Registration* or *Same Day Voter Registration*. This allows Iowans to register to vote during in-person absentee voting at your county auditor's office or at the polling place on Election Day.

REGISTERING TO VOTE IN IOWA

Your voice matters and it starts with knowing your eligibility. You can register to vote in the State of Iowa if you are:

☐ A United States citizen

☐ At least 17 years old

☐ An Iowa resident, with primary residence in the state



You can vote in local, state, and federal elections in Iowa if you:

☐ Are not a convicted felon (unless your voting rights have been restored by the Governor, including through Executive Order)

☐ Will be 18 years old on or before the general election, you will be able to vote in the primary election
